**Hawk Hill Pictures Boards Worldwide Distribution for True-Story Drama *Conceivable*:  
Tackles Unplanned Pregnancy at 45**



March 17, 2026 — Mars, PA — Hawk Hill Pictures has acquired worldwide distribution rights to *Conceivable*, a faith-informed dramatic feature inspired by the true story of pastor, author and producer Beth Caulfield. The film follows a midlife woman confronting an unexpected pregnancy and the profound personal, spiritual, and emotional questions that unfold as a result.

The film stars Jana Lee Hamblin (*Until the Last Promise*, *The West Wing*), Dean Cain (*God's Not Dead*, *Lois & Clark: The New Adventures of Superman*), and Eddie McClintock (*Miracle of Manchester*, *Warehouse 13*). Through character-driven storytelling, *Conceivable* explores themes of faith, dignity, and compassion while portraying the deeply human realities surrounding an unplanned pregnancy and the difficult choices many women face.

“Hawk Hill Pictures looks for stories that connect with audiences on a human level,” said Jen Katzfey, President of Hawk Hill Pictures. “What stood out about *Conceivable* is that it doesn’t treat its subject as a political argument. It tells a deeply human story about faith, dignity, and the difficult moments that shape our lives. That kind of authenticity is exactly what audiences are responding to.”

For Caulfield, the project reflects a deeply personal journey.

“This film grew out of my own experience,” said Caulfield. “We wanted to tell the story with honesty and compassion, acknowledging how complicated life can be. Faith often works quietly in the background of our hardest moments, and my hope is that women who face unexpected pregnancies later in life will feel seen, understood, and encouraged by this story.”

From its earliest development, *Conceivable* has been shaped by strong female leadership, with women leading the writing, directing, producing, marketing, and now distribution of the film. That perspective helped shape the film’s compassionate, character-driven approach to the complex realities surrounding the subject of abortion.

With a recognizable cast and a story rooted in real experience, *Conceivable* aims to reach audiences seeking thoughtful, faith-informed storytelling that explores complex issues through empathy and authenticity.

Hawk Hill Pictures plans a theatrical release for *Conceivable*, with dates to be announced.
